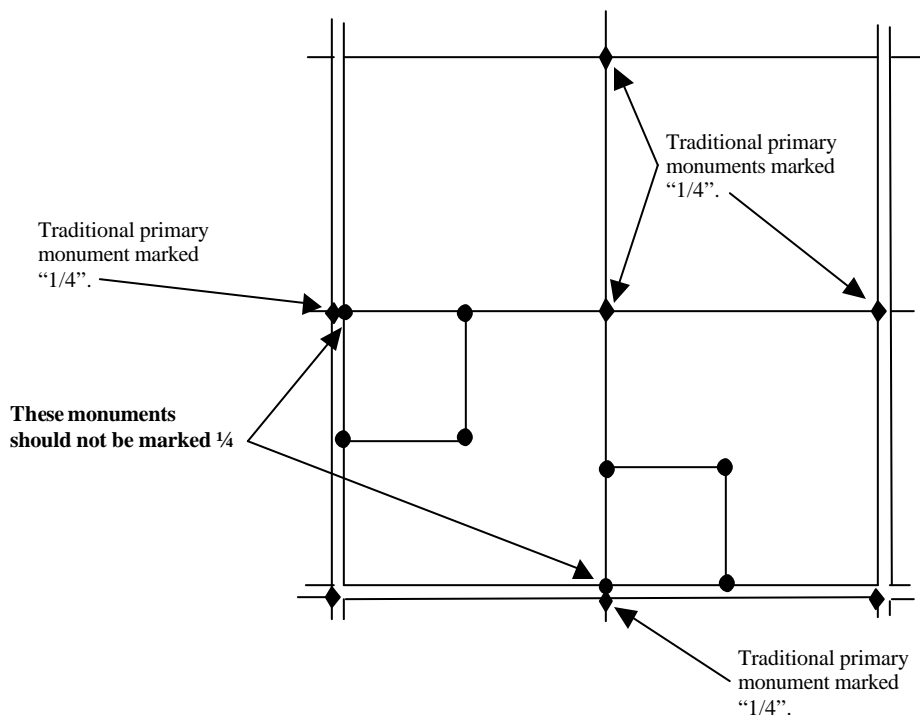

**Policy Statement:**

Monuments established to mark non-traditional primary quarter section corners shall not be marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Monuments marking the un-monumented side of a road allowance are considered a non-traditional primary monument.

For example: If a quarter section line is established and a monument is required on the intersection of the quarter section line with the unmonumented limit of the road allowance, that monument is not considered to be a traditional primary survey monument and should not be marked as such.



<b>Purpose:</b>  This policy was developed in consultation with the Saskatchewan Land Surveyors Practice Committee, Controller of Surveys and ISC Surveys and Mapping. It was agreed that any quarter section monument that is marking the un-monumented side of a road allowance shall be considered a non-traditional primary monument and shall not be marked "1/4".
