



Registrars', Director's and Controller's Order Suspension of Registry Services and Functions

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas the land surveys directory, the corporate registry, the common business identifier program, the personal property registry, the judgment registry and the land registry services and functions are provided to the public by Information Services Corporation through their Customer Services Centres and their website.

And whereas for reasons of public health and safety it is desirable to suspend in-person service to the public for the registries:



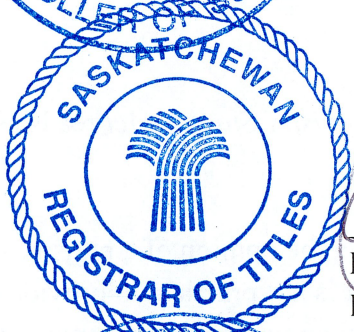


do hereby direct that effective at 5 p.m. March 16, 2020 in-person services for the registries will be suspended until further notice.


