

Registrars', Director's and Controller's Order Amendment of Order for Suspension of Registry Services and Functions

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas all **in-person services** provided to the public by Information Services corporation for the land surveys directory, the corporate registry, the common business identifier program, the personal property registry, the judgment registry and the land registry services and functions were suspended on **March 16, 2020 at 5 p.m.**
