Controller of Surveys' Order

Suspension of Mailing of Search Results by the Land Surveys Directory – Canada Post Labour Disruption

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas subsection 79(1) of *The Land Surveys Act*, 2000 reads as follows:

79(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, any regulation made pursuant to this Act, or any other Act providing for the approving or placing of documents in the land surveys directory, where, in the opinion of the Controller, it is not practical to provide one or more land surveys directory functions, the Controller may, by order, suspend all or any land surveys directory functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the Controller, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, November 15, 2024, land surveys directory services to mail search results pursuant to section 140 of *The Land Surveys Regulations* became unavailable due to a labour disruption at Canada Post.

Therefore I, Alan Jensen, Controller of Surveys, do hereby order effective 12:01 a.m. November 15, 2024 the suspension of the mailing of search results in the land surveys directory.
