Suspension of Mailing of Notices and Verifications by the Corporate Registry – Postal Labour Disruption

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas the Corporate Registry may send notices both via an electronic service and mail service pursuant to *The Business Corporations Act, 2021, The Non-profit Corporations Act, 2022, The Co-operatives Act, 1996, The New Generation Co-operatives Act, The Business Names Registration Act, and The Partnership Act.*


And whereas at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, November 15, 2024, certain registry services are unavailable due to a postal labour disruption by Canada Post, namely: Mailed notices in the Corporate Registry by Canada Post.

Therefore I, Jared Pashovitz, Deputy Registrar of Corporations, do hereby order:

- 1) Suspension of Services.

The mailing of notices of the Corporate Registry is hereby suspended.
