



**Registrar's Order
Suspension and Recommencement of Operation of the Land Registry**

Whereas subsection 15(1) of *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act* reads as follows:

15(1) Notwithstanding any other Act or law, if, in the opinion of a registry officer or the minister, the circumstances are such that it is not practical to provide one or more registry services or functions, a registry officer or the minister may, by order, suspend all or any registry services or functions for the period during which, in the opinion of the registry officer or the minister, those circumstances prevail.

And whereas the land registry services and functions are provided to the public by Information Services Corporation through their Customer Services Centres and their website.


And whereas at 7:05 a.m. on Wednesday, December 7, 2016, all land registry services and functions became unavailable due to a technical systems service disruption.

Therefore I, Karen E. Banks, Registrar of Titles, do hereby determine that the operation of all land registry services and functions were suspended and recommenced as follows:

- Suspended and not available to the public and registry personnel from 7:05 a.m. on Wednesday, December 7, 2016;
- Recommenced and made available to registry personnel for the purposes of readying the system for access by the public from 6:59 a.m. on Thursday, December 8, 2016; and
- Recommenced and made available to the public at 11:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 13, 2016.
