Final Reminder: GeoSask Service and Website Closing Down on May 19, 2016

As you may be aware, GeoSask is a collaborative initiative between the Government of Saskatchewan and Information Services Corporation (ISC) that provides you access to Saskatchewan geographic information system (GIS) data and maps through the www.geosask.ca website.

Following a joint decision by the Government of Saskatchewan and ISC, the GeoSask service and website will no longer be operational after May 19, 2016.

Please visit <u>gis.saskatchewan.ca</u> for information on Government of Saskatchewan spatial information including datasets currently available via GeoSask. The Government of Saskatchewan's new site is under development but is expected to be available prior to May 19, 2016.
