GeoSask Conclusion FAQ's

Why is www.GeoSask.ca being shut down?

The agreement between the Government of Saskatchewan and Information Services Corporation will end on May 19, 2016, therefore www.GeoSask.ca will no longer be operational.

Why are you now charging for data that I could get for free on GeoSask.ca?

Certain data sample sets on Geosask.ca were and will remain free for non-commercial users and will be offered at www.isc.ca/MapsandPhotos/GISData. Commercial users will need to contact us to discuss entering into a license agreement to purchase data.

Closure of www.GeoSask.ca will affect me or my business. What options do I have to continue on? You may still use this data commercially, provided you enter into a new license agreement with ISC.

Who does this change affect?

Anyone downloading data from GeoSask, or who uses the GeoSask website to view and obtain map and data information about Saskatchewan. This letter is to let customers know GeoSask.ca will no longer be operational after May 19, 2016.

Which data does this apply to?

This data applies to all data sets on GeoSask.ca.

Which groups will still be able to receive the data for free?

Data used for emergency and educational purposes will still be allowed to access the data free of charge (distribution fee and or labour fee may apply). We recommend that you contact us at ask@isc.ca or call 1-866-275-4721 to confirm if you are within these categories.

Can I still download the data for free?

Yes, until the decommission date of May 19, 2016.

When will this email be sent out?

Tuesday, April 5th 2016.
