New West Partnership Trade Agreement

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INSTRUCTIONS

This form is used to complete the updates to the attorney information of a Saskatchewan corporation extra-provincially registered in Alberta in compliance with the provisions of the New West Partnership Trade Agreement (NWPTA).

For new registrations, items 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6 must be completed and provide the Saskatchewan entity number.

For changes, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 must be completed.

1. Enter the name of the corporation.
2. Enter the corporate access number issued by Alberta and the Saskatchewan entity number.
3. Check the appropriate box (es). Only one attorney appointment, resignation or change can be recorded per form. Attorneys must be individuals. A resigning attorney must confirm that at least 60 days' notice has been given to the extra-provincial corporation at its head office.
4. Enter the full name of the individual who has been appointed as the attorney or alternative attorney.
5. Enter the complete address of the attorney. This address must be accessible to the public and must be within Alberta. Enter the street or a postal box address followed by the legal land description (LLD), city, province (must be Alberta), and postal code.
6. Enter the full name of the attorney and the date the attorney consented to their appointment.

The form must include:

- The name of the person authorizing the registration (authorized representative)
- Title (relationship to corporation)
- Signature
- Date signed
