

Compulsory Discharge of Registration DEMAND TO CREDITOR

The Enforcement of Money Judgments Act – Section 28

	Pursuant to subsection 28(4) of <i>The Enforcement of Money Judgments Act (EMJA)</i> , you are hereby required, not later than 15 days after this demand is served upon you: to discharge or amend the judgment registration as follows:
b)	OR to apply to the court to maintain or amend the judgment registration and provide a copy of the application to the Registrar of Personal Property Security.
4.	The demand for the discharge or amendment is for the following reason: pursuant to clause 28(2)(a) of EMJA, the judgment has been satisfied, withdrawn or is not enforceable (does not include a judgment that is not enforceable as a result of an order staying enforcement of the judgment or an order made pursuant to section 81 of <i>The Queen's Bench Act, 1998</i>); pursuant to clause 28(2)(b) of EMJA, the person named in the registration is not a judgment debtor of the person named as judgment creditor; pursuant to clause 28(2)(c) of EMJA, the court has ordered that the registration be discharged or amended; or pursuant to clause 28(2)(d) of EMJA, property affected by the registration has been sold by the sheriff to a person entitled to have the registration discharged or amended.
	If you fail to comply with this demand, then pursuant to subsection 28(5) of EMJA, I may apply to discharge or amend the judgment registration without further notice to you.
